#### **Product 1: Einbecker Winterbock**

ABV: 7.5%

Einbecker Brauhaus AG, Einbeck Germany



From the home of the original Bock Beer. This beer is brewed under the German Purity Law of 1516 and is strong in flavor, yet malty in character.

Formats: 11.2oz bottles & kegs

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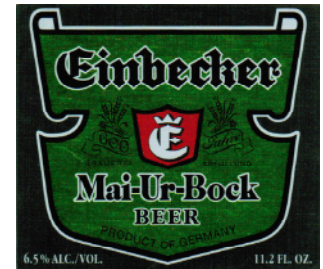
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#### **Product 2: Einbecker Mai Ur Bock**

ABV: 6.5%

Einbecker Brauhaus AG, Einbeck Germany



Released in March each year, this beer is designed to have a more refreshing, bubbly, and soft character than its fall sibling, perfectly suited for a new spring day.

Formats: 11.2oz bottles & kegs

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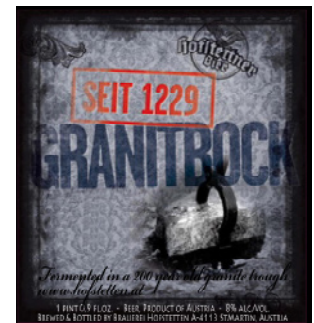
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#### **Product 3: Granit Bock**

ABV: 7.4%

Brauerei Hofstetten, St Martin Austria

This beer is brewed according to the historic beer style “Stone Beer” (Stein Bier) that comes from the Baden-Wurttemberg & Franconia regions of Germany and the Kaerten region in Austria, and dates back to the Middle Ages.

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#### Product 4: Ettaler Curator Dunkler Doppelbock

ABV: 9.0%

Klosterbrauerei Ettal, Ettal Germany

This beer is from one of the last authentic German monastic breweries Klosterbrauerei Ettal in Bavaria. Over the past years many of the classic bottom-fermenting Doppelbocks have been “adjusted” to make them “easier to drink”, but this was created for our US customers based on the authentic recipe dating back to 1330 when the monastery was established.

#### Product 5: Aecht Schlenkerla Eiche (Oak Smoke)

ABV: 8.0%

Brauerei Heller-Trum/Aecht Schlenkerla, Bamberg Germany

Following century-old recipes, all malts are dried over wood fire at the Schlenkerla brewery. Unlike the classic “Aecht Schlenkerla Rauchbier” which is kilned over beech wood, the Eiche is kilned over oak wood.

#### Product 6: Aventinus

ABV 8.0%

Privatbrauerei G. Schneider & Sohn, Kelheim, Germany

Aventinus is the world’s oldest top-fermenting wheat doppelbock - created in 1907. It was Georg Schneider’s creative response to bottom-fermenting doppelbock such as Salvator, Kulminator and Animator.

Formats: 16.9oz bottles & kegs



#### Product 7: Hitachino Nest Commerative Ale

ABV 7.5%

Kiuchi Brewery in Mito, Japan

This beer is brewed in tradition of a true Eisbock where the brew is concentrated by allowing the water to freeze (but not the alcohol).

Formats: 11.2oz bottles, 50.8oz bottles & kegs
